

Our Financial Report Year-to-Date

The average monthly giving through August exceeded the \$155,000 per month we needed to implement the 2014 budget. Therefore, we will start the new fiscal year in September without the need for another congregational meeting. We **thank you** for your faithfulness and generosity in giving to the General Fund in fiscal year 2013.

Financial Stewardship: Financial Concerns

Our giving through the first eleven months of our fiscal 2013 year was \$1,942,528. This places us \$52,167 <u>below</u> budget year-to-date.
