Will Metzger (University of Delaware – InterVarsity)

Will works with the students of UD, and notes that he's constantly challenged by the nature of today's secular university. He is continually battling the numerous forces opposing the gospel that feed information to students, such as at Stanford University, where they have appointed an "atheist chaplain" for non-believing students. This creates a great potential danger for "religious leaders" to distort the scriptures. Will uses his contact with the students to mentor, disciple and evangelize, and he leads chapel for the men's lacrosse team. Two of his former students who are now staff are focusing their ministry on the athletic community. He is also involved in the publication of "Tell the Truth," just printed in the 4th edition in English and the 3rd edition in Spanish.

Financial Stewardship: Financial Concerns

Our giving through the first eleven months of our fiscal 2013 year was \$1,942,528. This places us \$52,167 <u>below</u> budget year-to-date. Please continue to pray that God will help us through these uncertain times we are facing in today's very volatile economy. Remember your gifts are critical to supporting our vision and our mission, here in the Brandywine Valley and around the world.

Debt Reduction
