




What is The PATH?

Spotlight on current efforts of Brandywine-supported missionaries

Jim & Lynne Head (North Carolina)

Jim is the Pastoral Care Coordinator for World Team missionaries serving in North and South America. In May, Jim was visiting the northern coastal area of South America, meeting with local missionaries. This area is full of diverse ethnicity, culture, language and religion. The agency has ministries among tribal group, Hindustanis and Guyanese, but hopes to get more workers to reach the Chinese, Bush tribes, Javanese Muslims and Hindus. One couple in their ministry has led Wayana and Trio Indian tribes to know Christ, and these tribes are now actively reaching out to other tribes. A Bible in the Wayana language was recently completed, as well as a concordance. Jim writes in a recent newsletter, "Because of the spiritual needs within this ethnically and religiously diverse country, it is a place of opportunity for the gospel."

Our Financial Report Year-to-Date

This report will be updated monthly

The average monthly giving through August exceeded the \$155,000 per month we needed to implement the 2014 budget. Therefore, we will start the new fiscal year in September without the need for another congregational meeting. We **thank you** for your faithfulness and generosity in giving to the General Fund in fiscal year 2013.

Financial Stewardship: Financial Concerns

Our giving for fiscal 2013 year was \$2,103,308. This places us \$31,692 <u>below</u> budget. Please continue to pray that God will help us through these uncertain times we are facing in today's very volatile economy. Remember your gifts are critical to supporting our vision and our mission, here in the Brandywine Valley and around the world.

Debt Reduction Program

One of the <u>key objectives</u> identified by the <u>congregation</u> in the May surveys was to reduce our long-term debt faster than the current pay-off schedules. Thus, we have targeted paying off the Second Mortgage and the East/West Wing Mortgage by the end of 2015 (this is four years faster). We can accomplish this goal by average \$22,000 per month in debt reduction giving in the next 28 months. To put this in perspective, we can hit this goal if individually our giving increases by \$25 per month* above the current general fund contributions. By paying these mortgages off faster, we will free up \$100,000.00 per year, beginning in 2016 in the General Fund for expanding the Brandywine Ministries.
