A Study Through Colossians

1) Warning Against Empty Legalism v.16-17

Colossians 2:16 Therefore do not let anyone **judge** you by what you eat or drink, or with regard to a religious festival, a New Moon celebration or a Sabbath day.

Legalism: Trying to quantify spirituality through religious practices or a list of extra-biblical do's and don'ts and imposing your rules upon others.

Colossians 2:17 These are a shadow of the things that were to come; the reality, however, is found in Christ.

2) Warning Against Empty Mysticism v.18-19

Colossians 2:18-19 Do not let anyone who delights in false humility and the worship of angels disqualify you. Such a person also goes into great detail about what they have seen; they are puffed up with idle notions by their unspiritual mind.

Colossians 2:18-19 They have lost connection with the head, from whom the whole body, supported and held together by its ligaments and sinews, grows as God causes it to grow.

Gnostic Mysticism: Trying to quantify spirituality based on experiential encounters with God or spirit beings.

1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator also between God and men, the man Christ Jesus.

Hebrews 4:16 So let us come **boldly** to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive his mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it most.

3) Warning against Empty Asceticism v.20-23

Colossians 2:20-23 Since you died with Christ to the elemental spiritual forces of this world, why, as though you still belonged to the world, do you submit to its rules: "Do not handle! Do not taste! Do not touch!"?

Colossians 2:20-23 These rules, which have to do with things that are all destined to perish with use, are based on merely human commands and teachings.

Colossians 2:20-23 Such regulations indeed have an appearance of wisdom, with their selfimposed worship, their false humility and their harsh treatment of the body, but they lack any value in restraining sensual indulgence.

Asceticism: Trying to quantify spirituality based on extreme self-denial

v.23 but they lack any value in *restraining* sensual indulgence.

v.20 If you have died with Christ to the elementary principles of the world, why, as if you were living in the world, do you submit yourself to decrees.

Galatians 5:1 For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of bondage.
