Marriage should be honored by all, and the marriage bed kept pure, for God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral.


Pop-Culture view: Give your body but not your heart (Commitment free)

Biblical view: Sex consummates a wholehearted, exclusive union (Full-commitment) Pop-Culture view: Sex is a right to use for my own pleasure, so I can use it however I desire (self-centered)


Biblical view: Sex is a responsibility and gift for the pleasure of my spouse (self-giving)

Pop-Culture view: Sex is a just a chemical/biological release and doesn't mean anything (devalued)

Biblical view: Sex is a sacred, beautiful gift given to us by our creator (highly valued)








Roots of Depravity Genesis 1-2: God created everything good. God created everything to be in rhythm and harmony.


Roots of Depravity Genesis 3: Mankind commits treason against God. Harmony fractures
