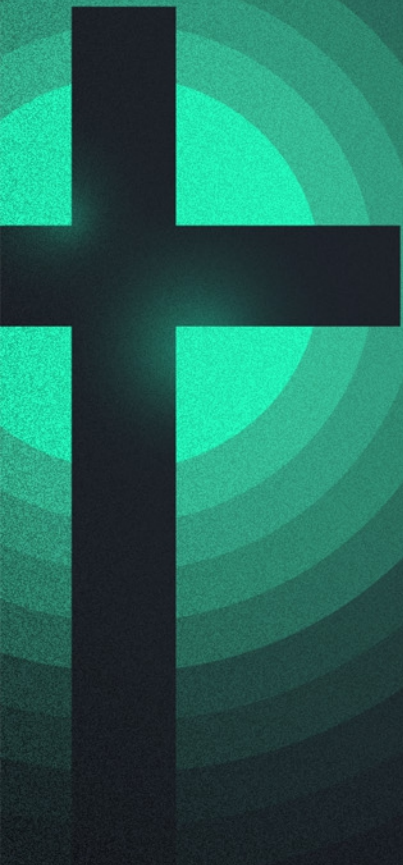

pleases the Lord.*




Exodus 20:12




Proverbs 30:17

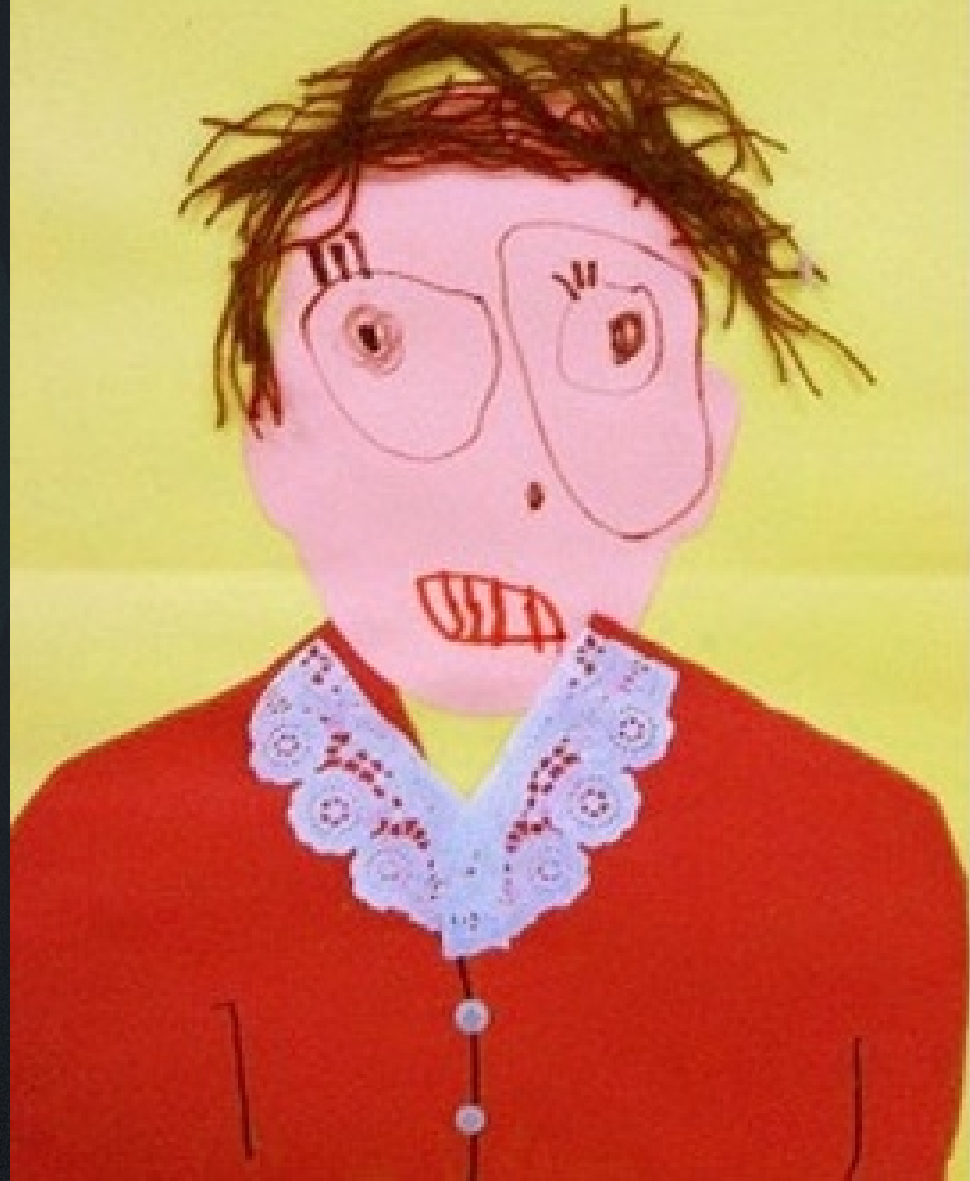

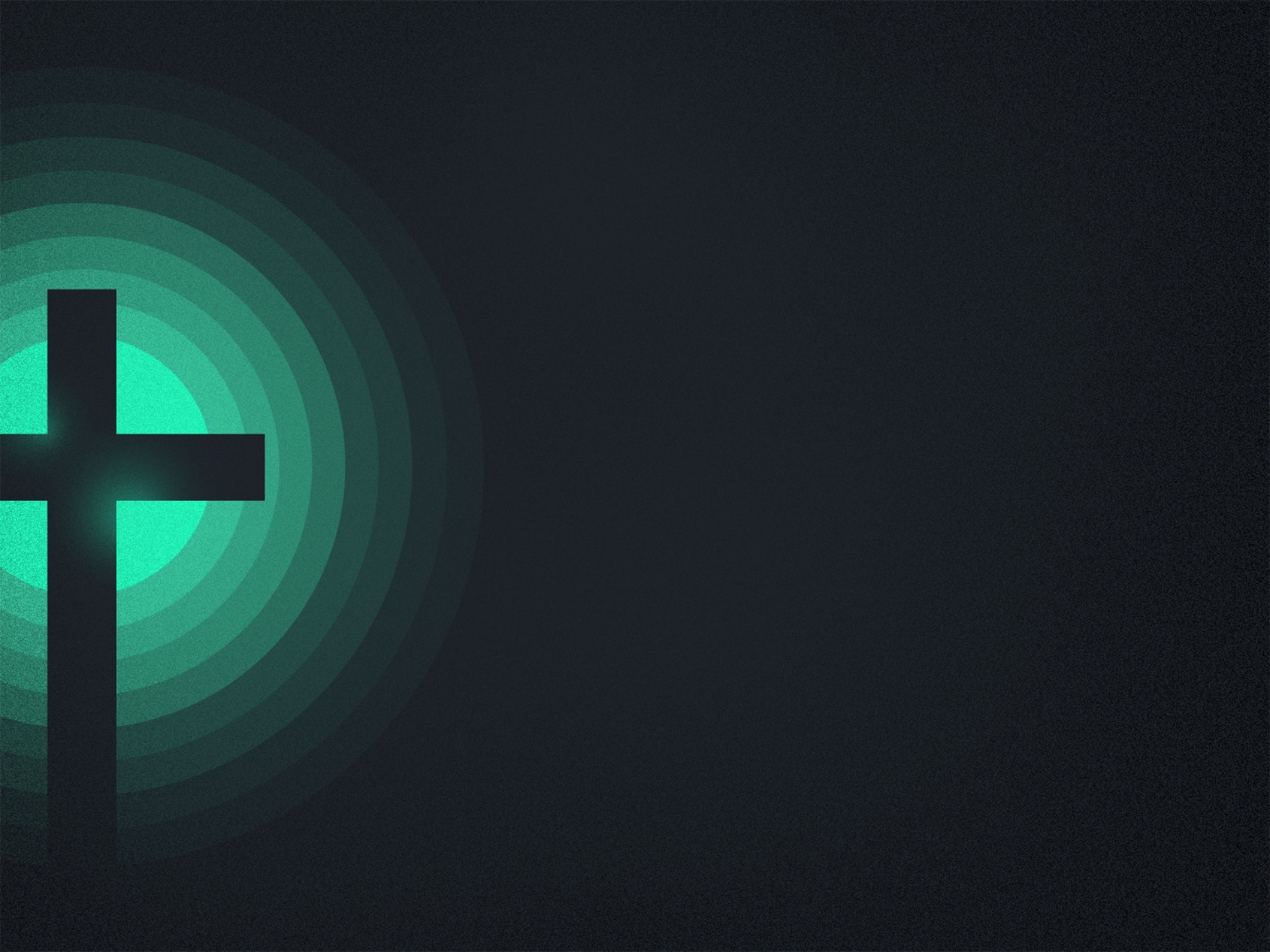

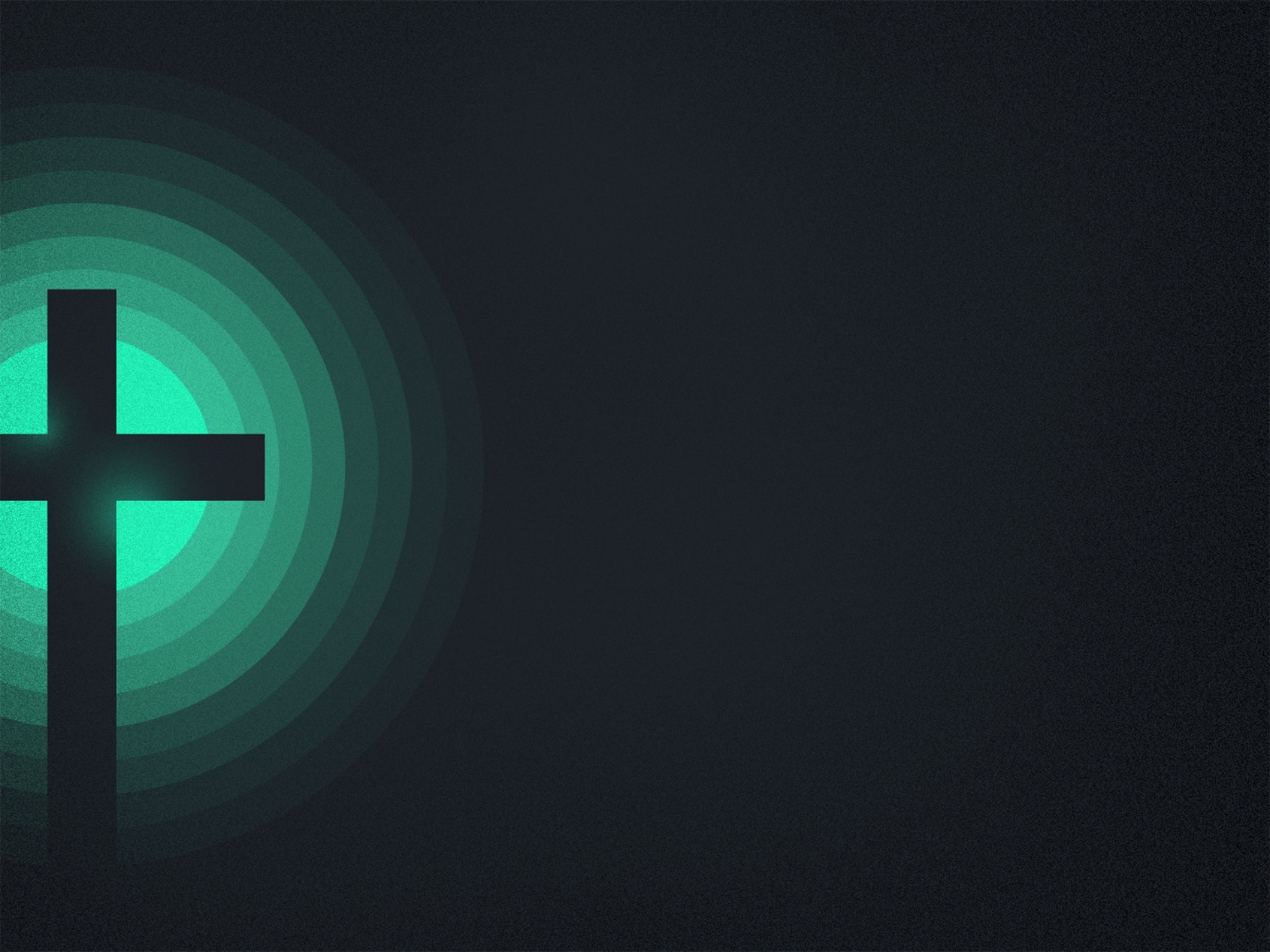
