When does human life begin?

Biblically- God creates human life at conception.



Psalms 139:13-16 For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb... When I was woven together in the depths of the earth, your eyes saw my unformed body...

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When does human life begin? Scientifically- Human life begins at conception.



1981 Senate Judiciary Subcommittee "Physicians, biologists, and other scientists agree that conception marks the beginning of the life of a human being-a being that is alive and is a member of the human species. There is overwhelming agreement on this point in countless medical, biological and scientific writings."

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Father of Modern Genetics- Dr. Jerome Lejeune

"To accept the fact that after fertilization has taken place a new human has come into being is no longer a matter of taste or opinion...it is plain experimental evidence. Each individual has a very neat beginning, at conception."





Does a mother have the right to choose abortion?



Mary Elizabeth Williams, "So what if abortion ends life", 2013 "Yet I know that throughout my own pregnancies, I never wavered for a moment in the belief that I was carrying a human life inside of me. I believe that's what a fetus is: a human life. And that doesn't make me one iota less solidly pro-choice."

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"Here's the complicated reality in which we live: All life is not equal...A fetus can be a human life without having the same rights as the woman in whose body it resides. She's the boss. Her life and what is right for her circumstances and her health should automatically trump the rights of the non-autonomous entity inside her. Always."





"On March 6, 1857, the Supreme Court, in Dred Scott vs. Stanford, rule that no act of Congress or territorial legislature could make laws banning slavery. The fundamental argument was that slaves are not free and equal persons but the property of their masters. The ruling is analogous to Roe Vs. Wade because today no state may make a law banning abortion to protect the unborn."

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"The argument is similar: basically because the unborn are at the sovereign disposal of their mothers and do not have personal standing in their own right... And today, 130 years later, we look back with amazing consensus and marvel at the blindness of our forefathers and fail to see it in ourselves." -John Piper SANCTITY IL IFF


