
## 2) Hypercritical Judgment

# Matthew 7:5


*First take the plank out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye.*

# 3 stages of spiritual maturity


## Stage Two

anyone else's sin.


# 3 stages of spiritual maturity
