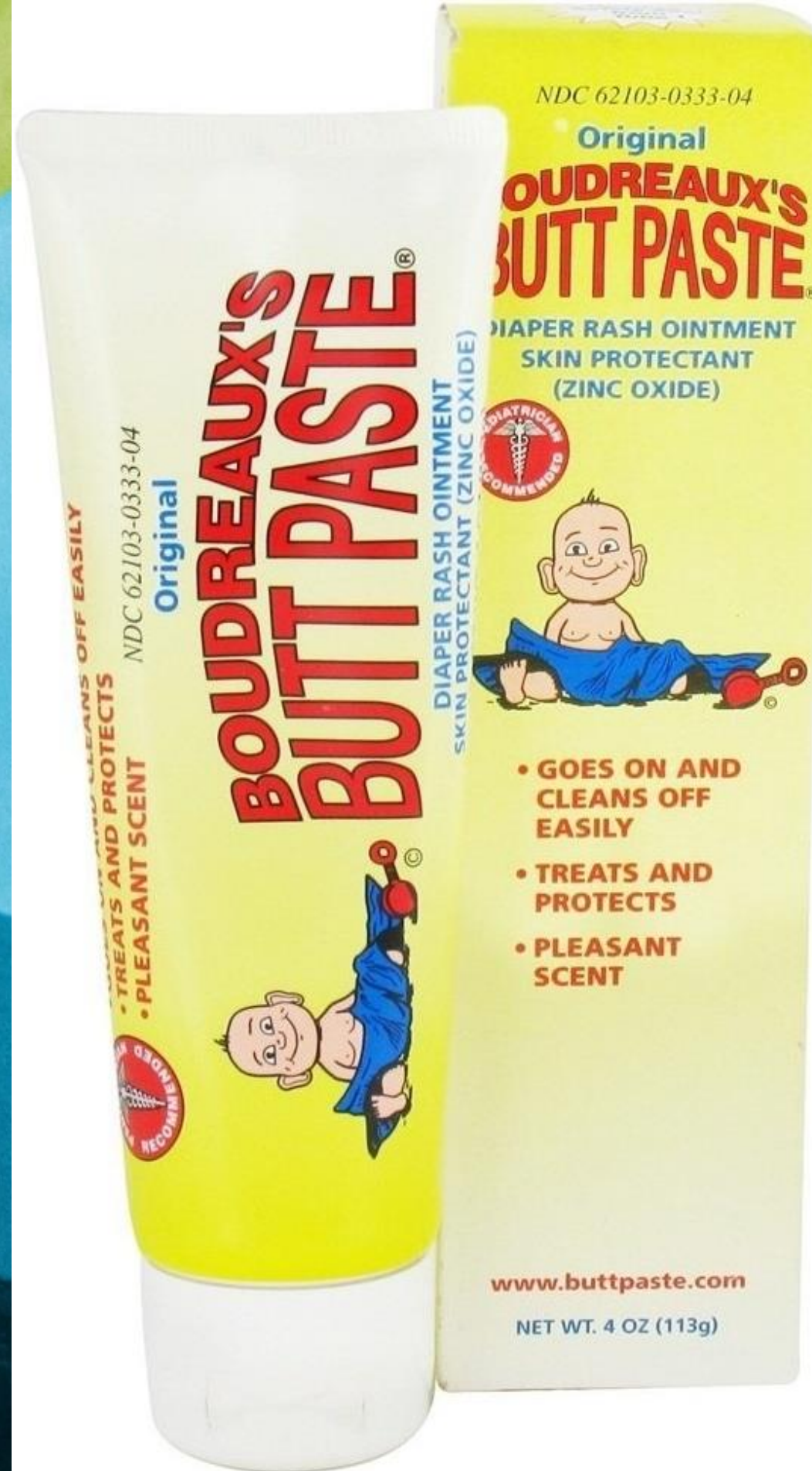


How we Judge RIGHTLY

brother's eye.*

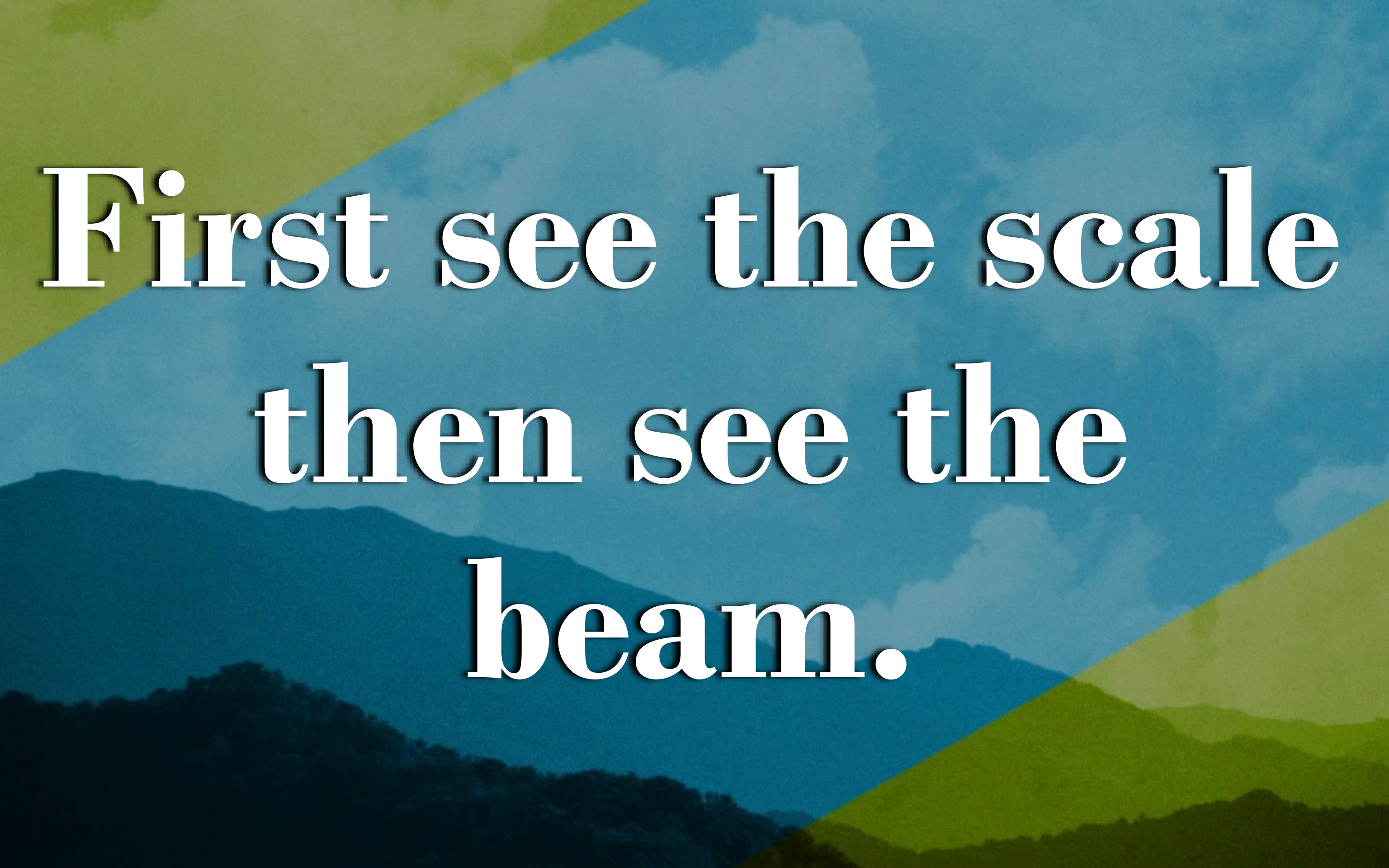
Hebrews 3:12

3 stages of spiritual maturity


Stage Two
