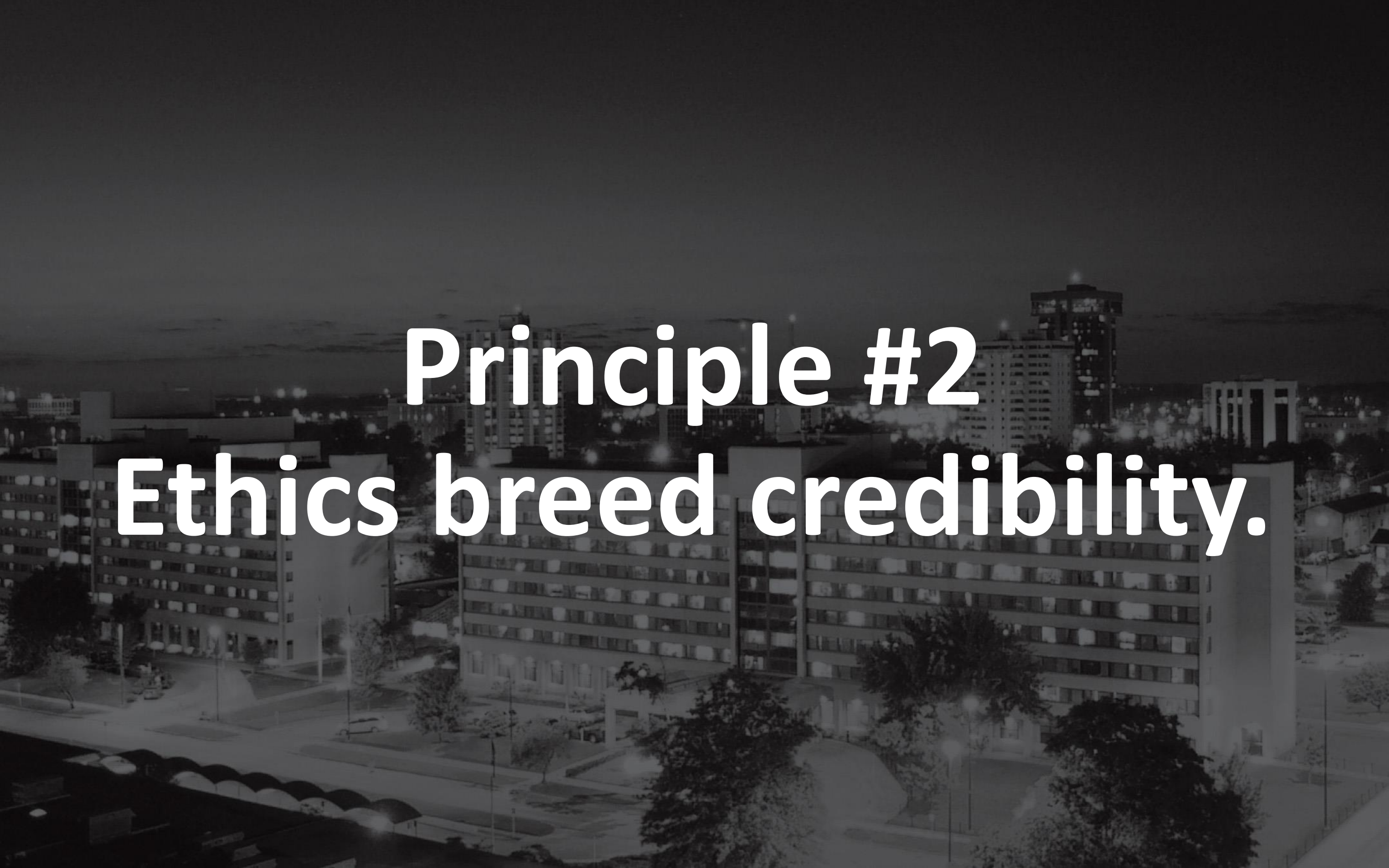
Principle #1

1 Peter 2:12

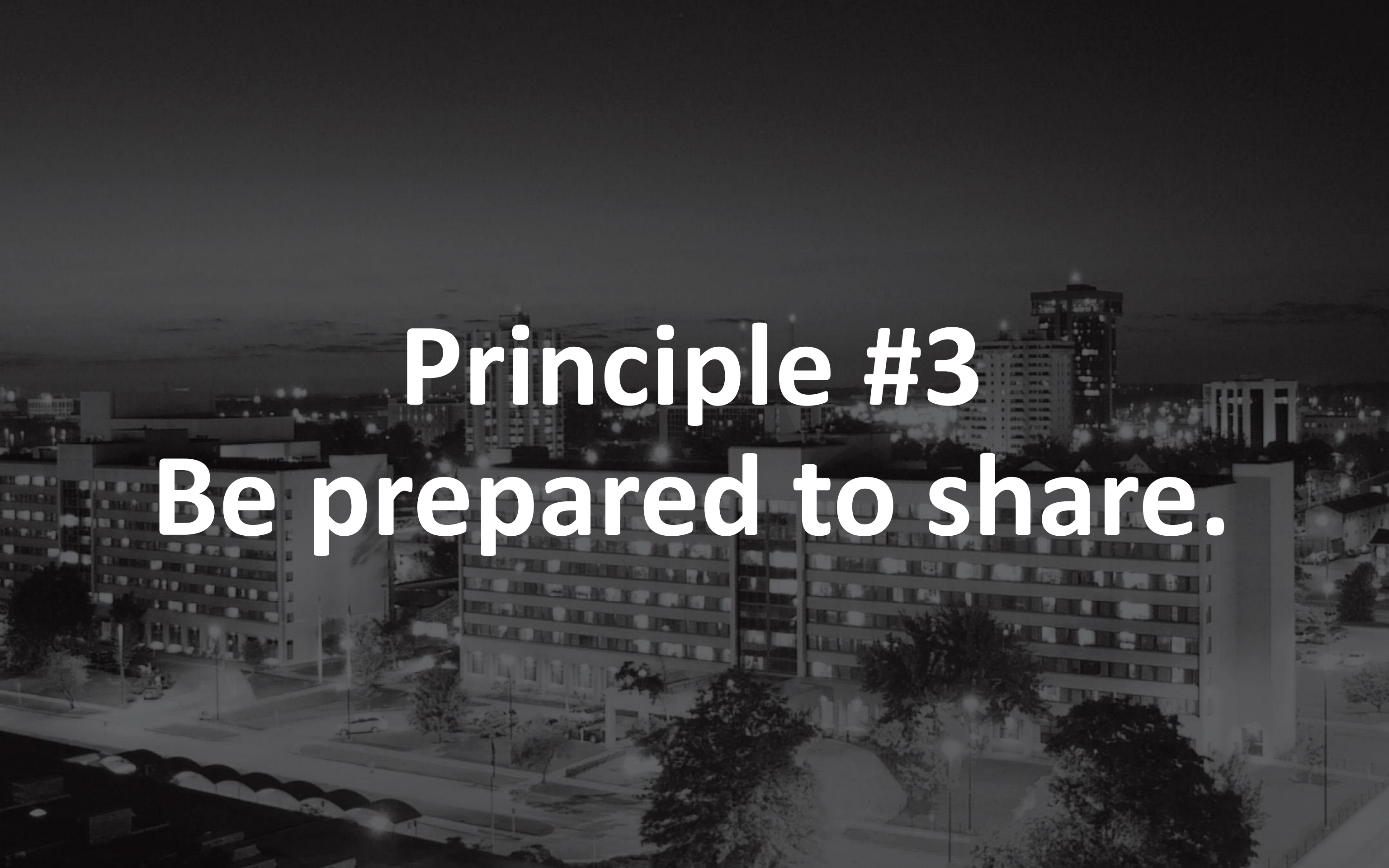




Be prepared to share.
