



#1 RELATIVISM will fail you.




Romans 2:12-16


Moralism's fatal flaw:

Diagnosing a Dead Faith


1) You have a HEAD-DEEP but not HEART-DEEP faith.

#3 Our only hope. V.25-27 "A Circumcised Heart"

> ROMANS PART I: THE PROBLEM

Romans 2:28-29

28 A person is not a Jew who is one only outwardly, nor is circumcision merely outward and physical. 29 No, a person is a Jew who is one inwardly; and circumcision is circumcision of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the written code. Such a person's praise is not from other people, but from God.
