CONTEXT: Jew and Gentile Relations



Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile.

Reason #1 We exchanged the truth about God for a lie. Romans 1:18-21



Reason #2 We exchanged worship of God for worship of idols.

Romans 1:22-23, 25-26



Reason #3 We exchanged obedience to God for obedience to our desires. Romans 1:24, 26-32



Romans 2:1 You, therefore, have no excuse, you who pass judgment on someone else, for at whatever point you judge another, you are condemning yourself, because you who pass judgment do the same things.



Romans 3:9-10 ⁹ What shall we conclude then? Do we have any advantage? Not at all! For we have already made the charge that Jews and Gentiles alike are all under the power of sin. ¹⁰ As it is written: "There is no onerighteous, not even one.

Romans 3:21 But now apart from the law the righteousness of God has been made known.



THREE BIGWORDS Justification Redemption Propitiation





JUSTIFICATION: "The WHAT of God's Provision" Romans 3:22-24 ²² This righteousness is given through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference between Jew and Gentile, ²³ for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, ²⁴ and all are

justified freely by his grace.



JUSTIFICATION

In the legal courtroom of heaven, sinners are declared "not guilty." They are declared "righteous" in God's sight through faith in Jesus Christ





REDEMPTION: "The HOW of God's Provision"

Romans 3:24 and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.





REDEMPTION

Jesus pays the price of our debt that enslaved us and sets us free.





PROPITIATION: The "WHY of God's Provision" Romans 3:25 God presented Christ as a sacrifice of atonement through the shedding of his blood-to be

received by faith.



PROPITIATION

God's just wrath is satisfied by the sacrifice of Jesus Christ.
