¹¹In the same way, consider yourselves to be dead as far as sin is concerned. Now you believe in Christ Jesus. So consider yourselves to be alive as far as God is concerned. ¹²So don't let sin rule your body, which is going to die. Don't obey its evil desires. ¹³Don't give any part of yourself to serve sin. Don't let any part of yourself be used to do evil. Instead, give yourselves to God. You have been brought from death to life. So give every part of yourself to God to do what is right. ¹⁴Sin will no longer control you like a master. That's because the law does not rule you. God's grace has set you free.
