⁴¹“Two people owed money to a certain lender. One owed him 500 silver coins. The other owed him 50 silver coins.

⁴²Neither of them had the money to pay him back. So he let them go without paying. Which of them will love him more?”

⁴³Simon replied, “I suppose the one who owed the most money.”

¹⁴“I tell you, the tax collector went home accepted by God. But not the Pharisee. All those who lift themselves up will be made humble. And those who make themselves humble will be lifted up.”
