- 1. **HEAR Mark 4:23-24** If anyone has ears to hear, let him hear. Consider carefully what you hear.
- 2. **BELIEVE Acts 16:30-31** He then brought them out and asked, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household."
- 3. **CONFESS 1 John 1:9** If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
- 4. **REPENT 2 Corinthians 7:10** Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret but worldly sorrow brings death.
- 5. **BE BAPTIZED Mark 16:15-16** Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved but whoever does not believe will be condemned.
