

## Mark 10:1-12 (New International Readers Version)

- <sup>1</sup>Jesus left that place and went into the area of Judea and across the Jordan River. Again crowds of people came to him. As usual, he taught them.
- <sup>2</sup> Some Pharisees came to test Jesus. They asked, "Does the Law allow a man to divorce his wife?"
- <sup>3</sup> "What did Moses command you?" he replied.
- <sup>4</sup>They said, "Moses allowed a man to write a letter of divorce and send her away."
- <sup>5</sup> "You were stubborn. That's why Moses wrote you this law," Jesus replied. <sup>6</sup> "But at the beginning of creation, God 'made them male and female.'
- 7 'That's why a man will leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife. 8 The two of them will become one.' They are no longer two, but one. 9 So no one should separate what God has joined together."
- <sup>10</sup> When they were in the house again, the disciples asked Jesus about this. <sup>11</sup> He answered, "What if a man divorces his wife and gets married to another woman? He commits adultery against her. <sup>12</sup> And what if she divorces her husband and gets married to another man? She commits adultery."
