<sup>°</sup> Asa became king of Judah. It was in the 20th year that Jeroboam was king of Israel. <sup>10</sup> Asa ruled in Jerusalem for 41 years. His grandmother's name was Maakah. She was Abishalom's daughter.

<sup>11</sup> Asa did what was right in the sight of the LORD. That's what King David had done. <sup>12</sup> Asa threw out of the land the male prostitutes who were at the temples. He got rid of all the statues of gods made by his people of long ago. <sup>13</sup> He even removed his grandmother Maakah from her position as queen mother. That's because she had made a pole used to worship the female god named Asherah. The LORD hated it. So Asa cut it down. He burned it in the Kidron Valley. <sup>14</sup> Asa didn't remove the high places from Israel. But he committed his whole life completely to the LORD. <sup>15</sup> He and his father had set apart silver, gold and other things to the LORD. Asa brought them into the LORD's temple.
