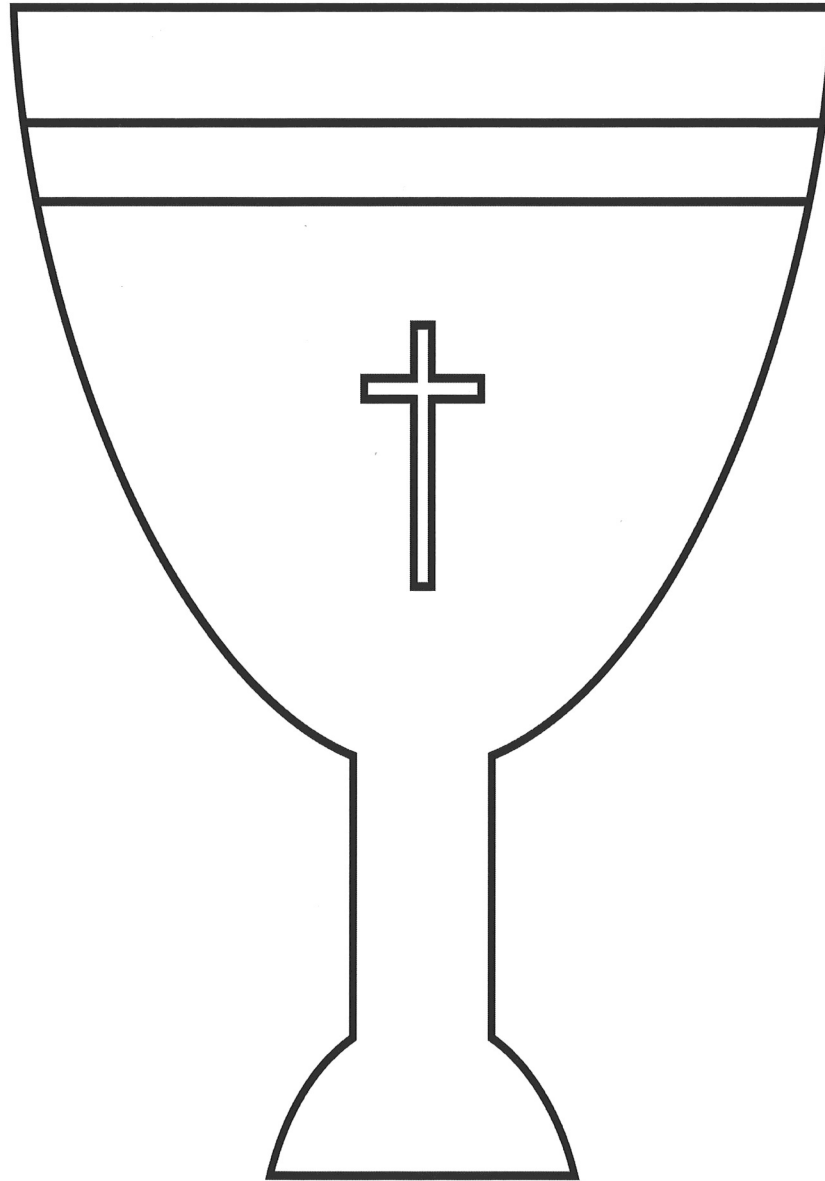

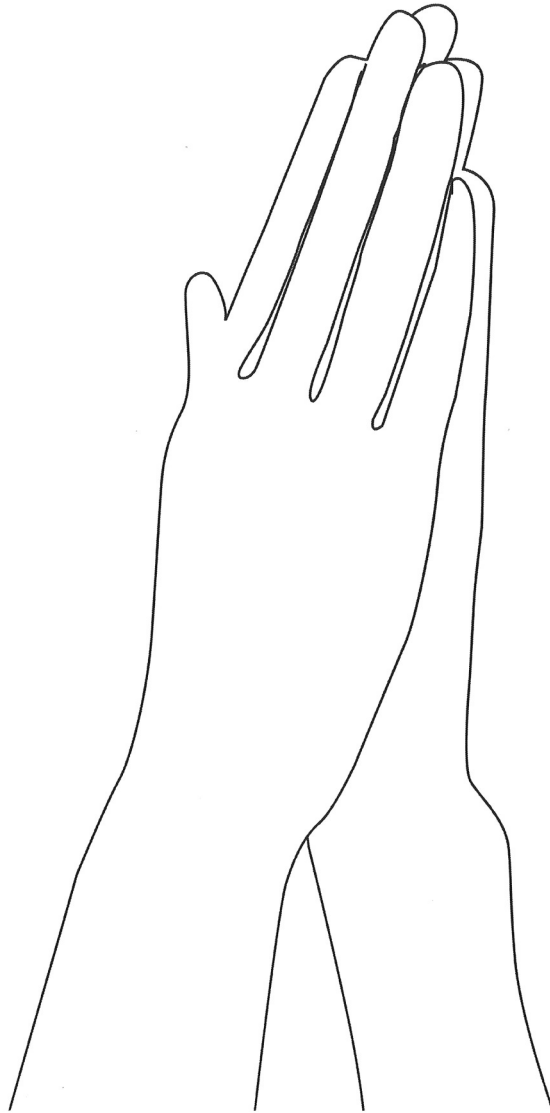
And He took a cup, and when He had given thanks He gave it to them, saying,

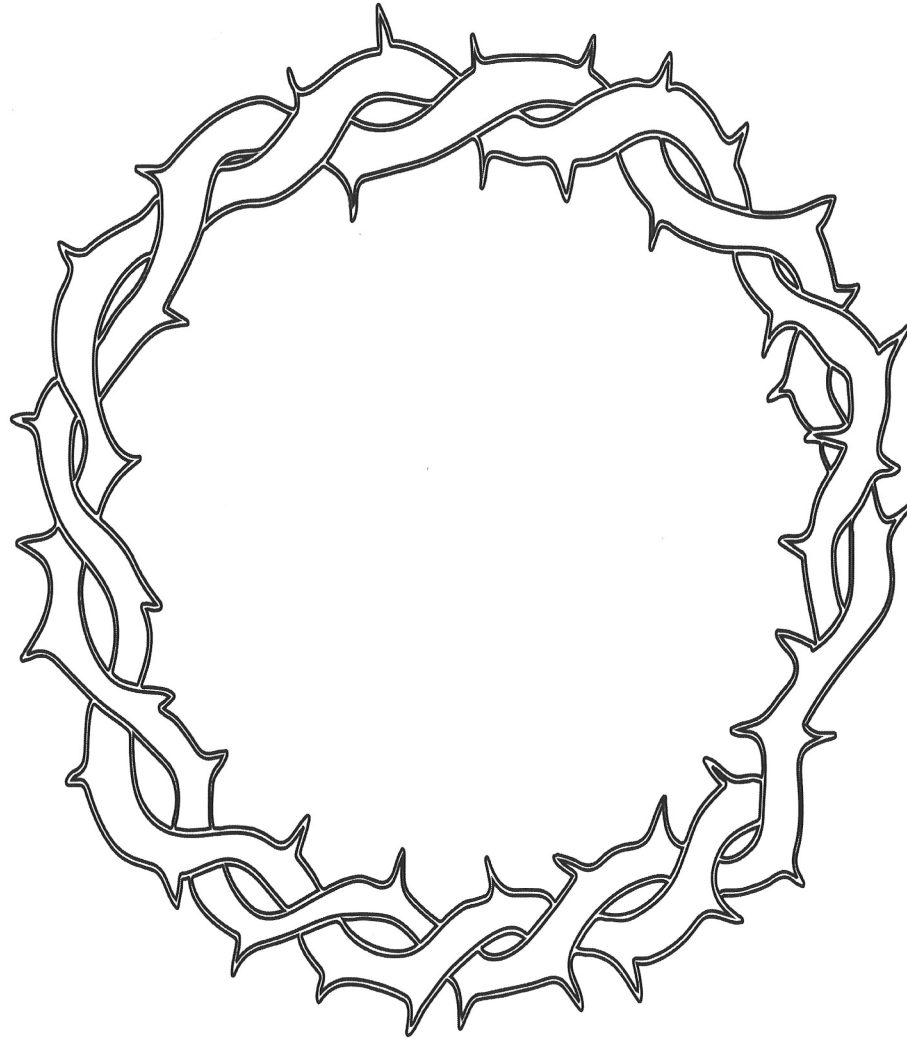
And they went to a place called Gethsemane. And He said to His disciples,

Mark 14: 32-34



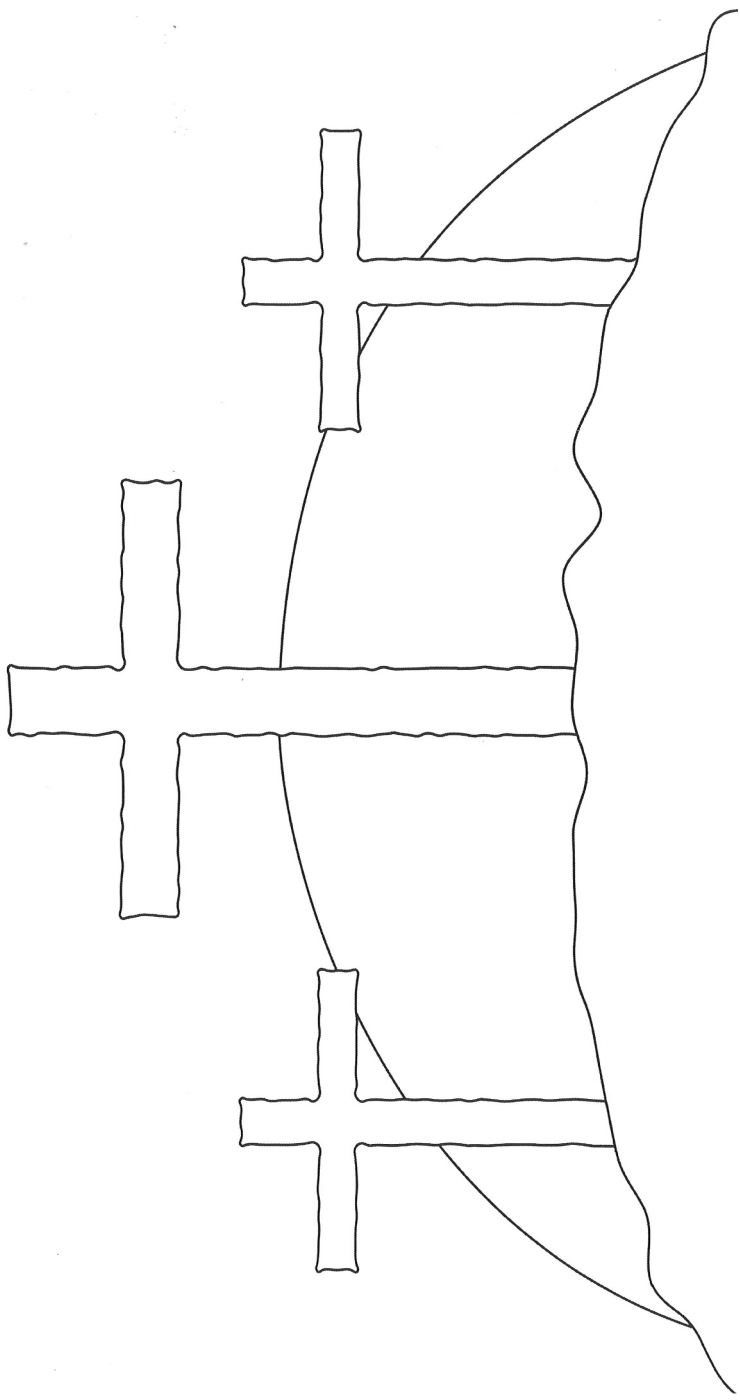
Then the soldiers of the governors took Jesus into the governor's headquarters...

Matthew 27: 27-29



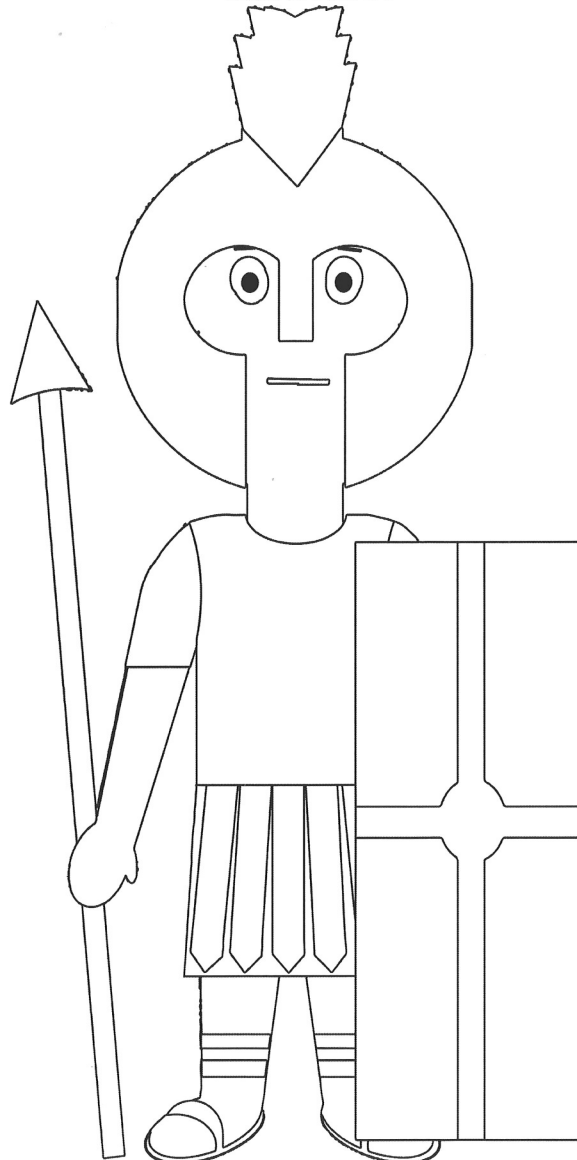
So they took Jesus, and He went out, bearing His own cross, to the place called the place of a skull,

John 19: 16-18

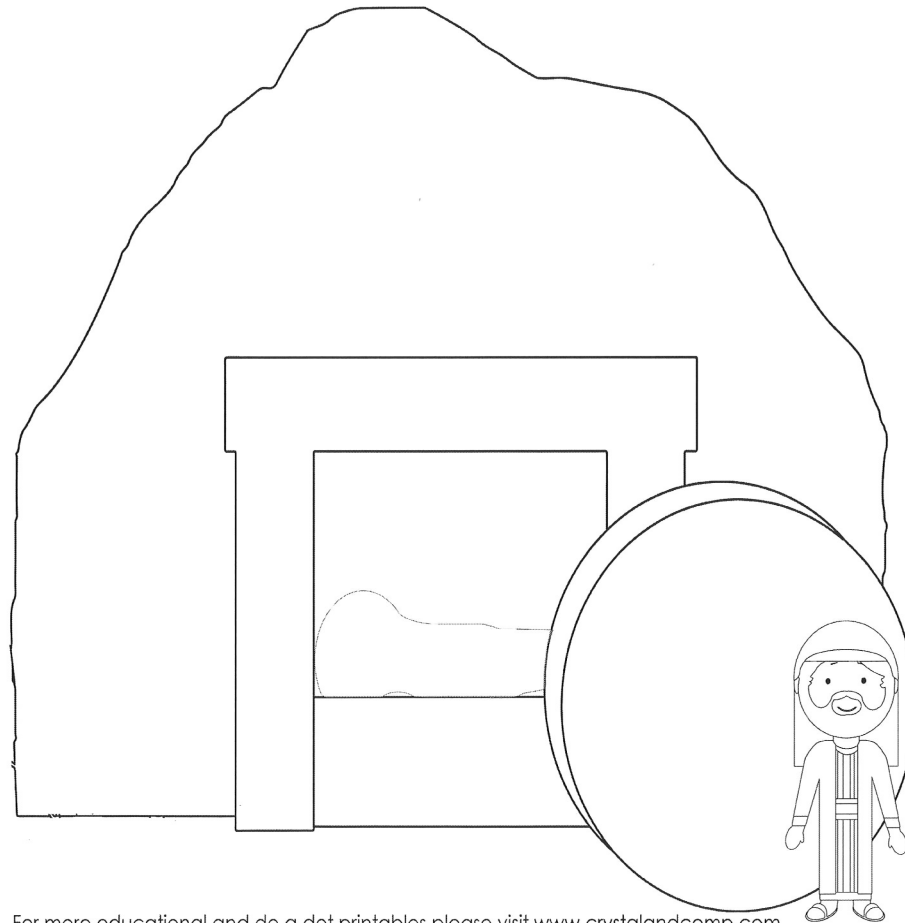

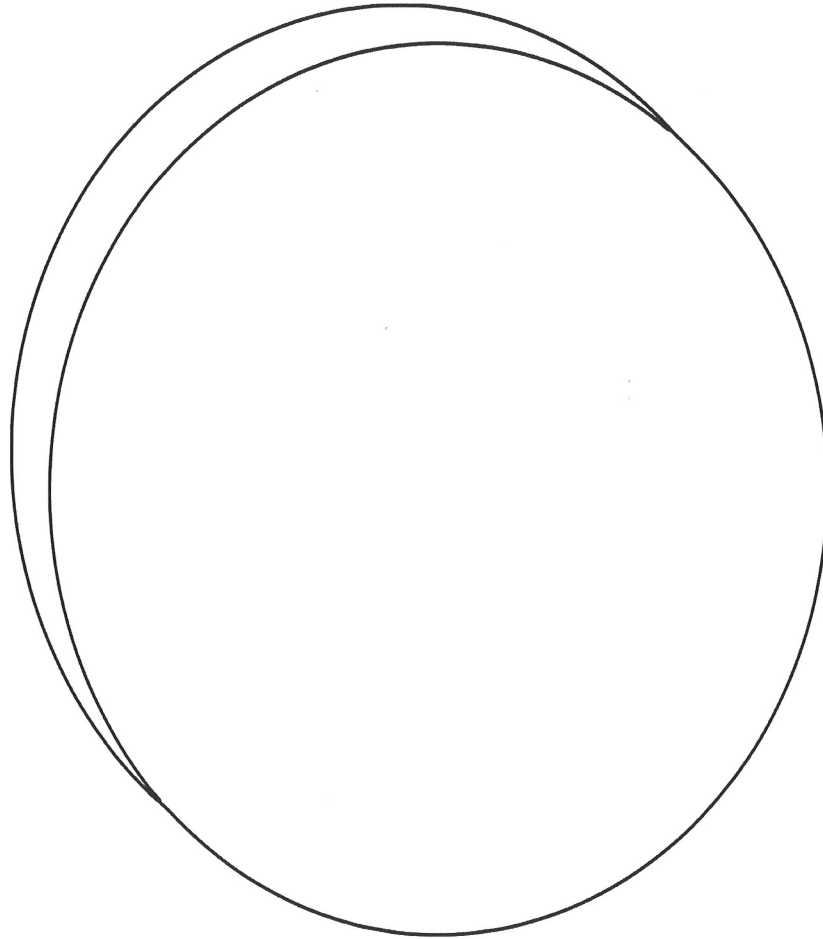

Matthew 2:57-60

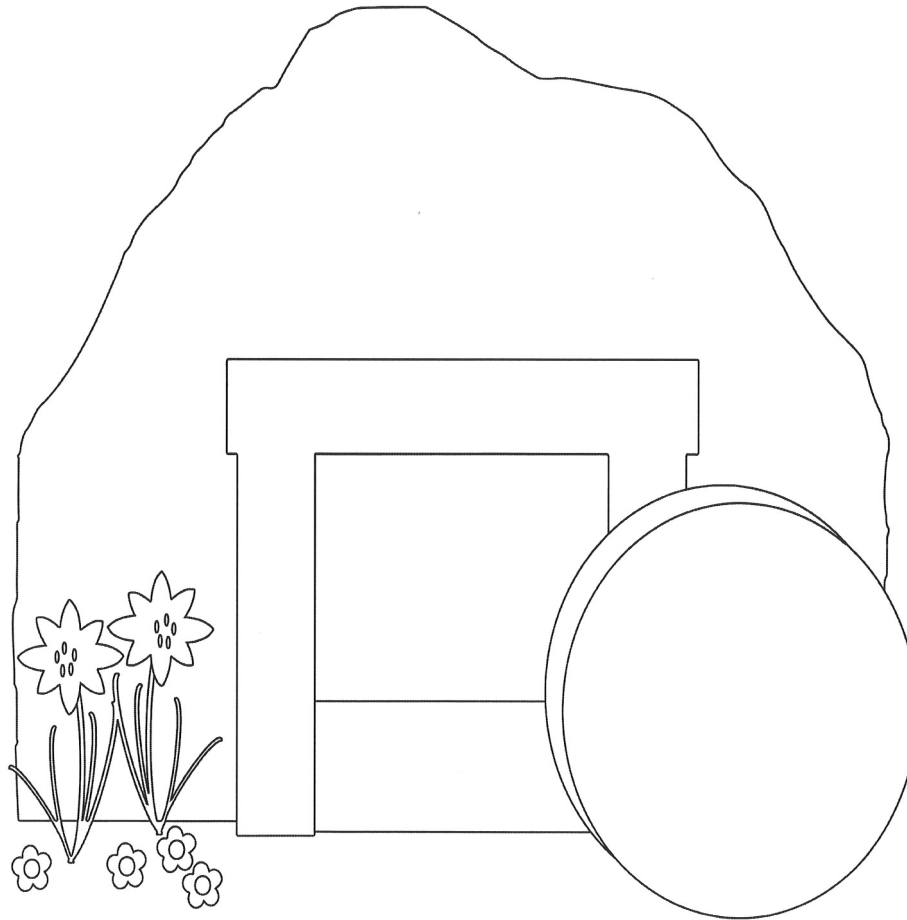


And behold, there was a great earthquake, for an angel of the

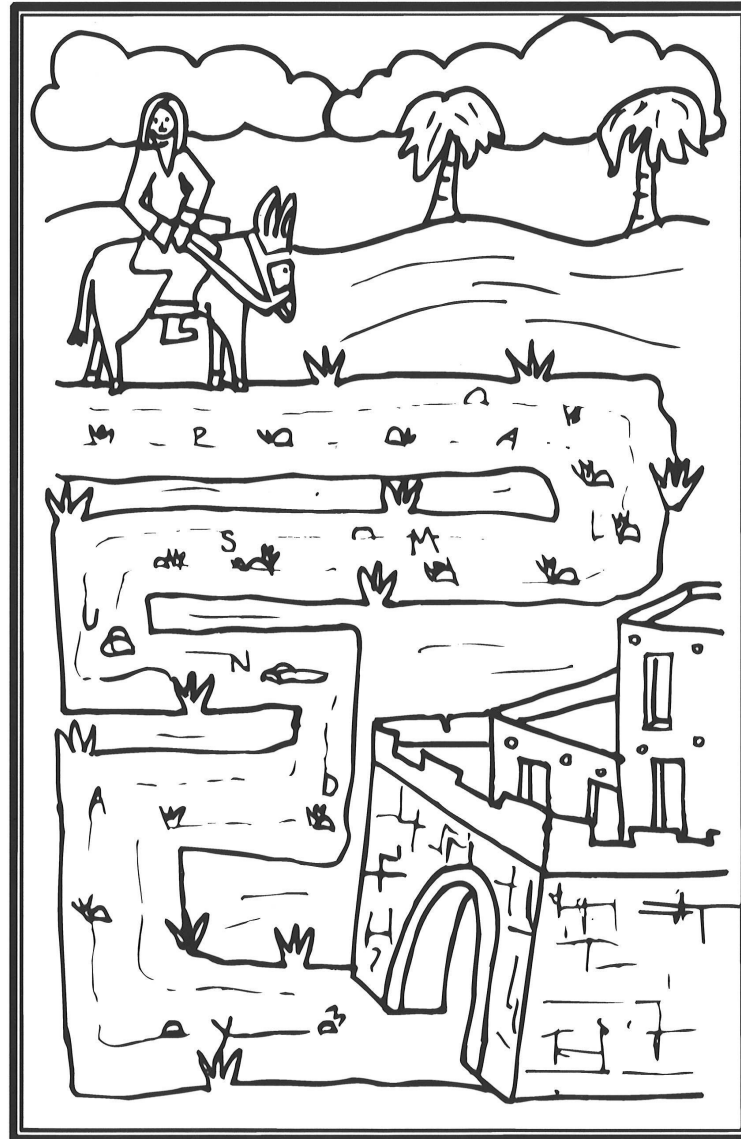

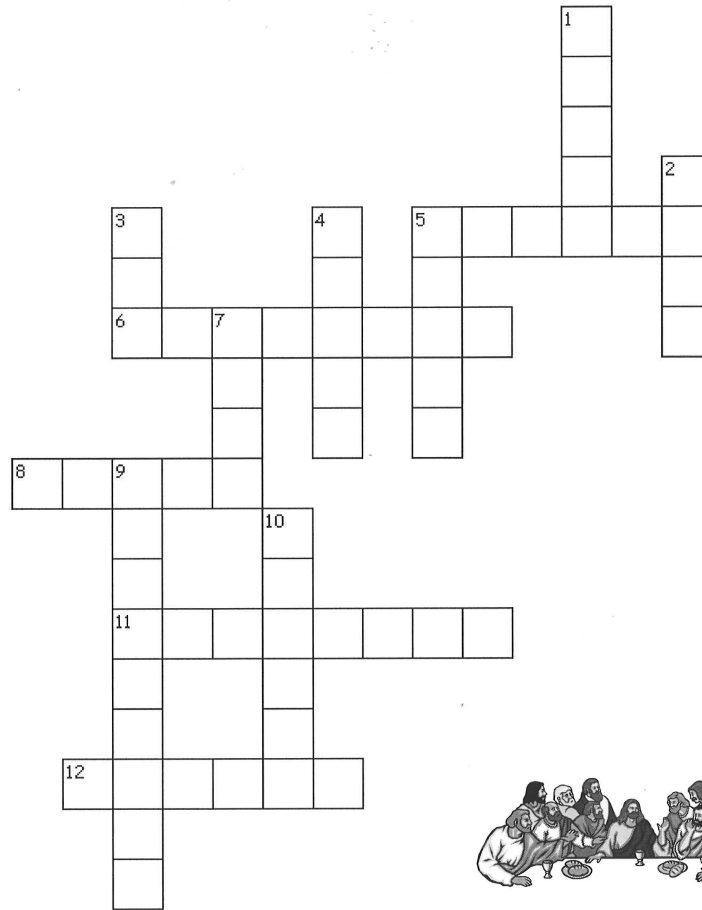
Triumphant Entry

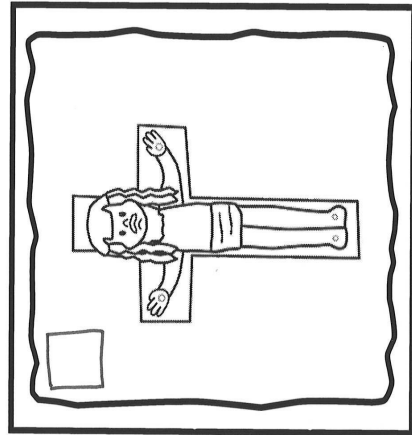
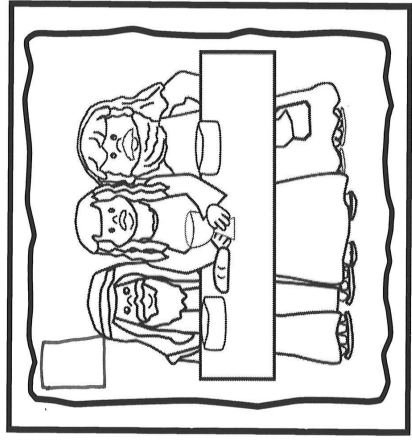
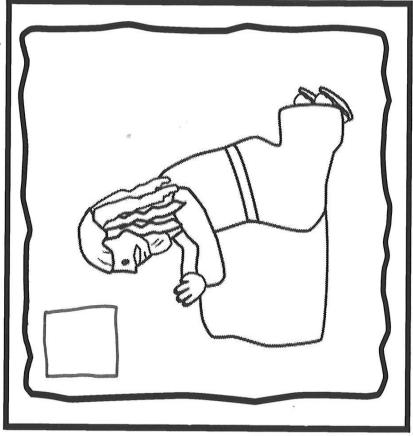
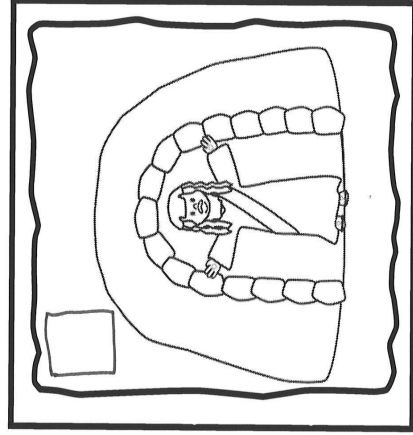
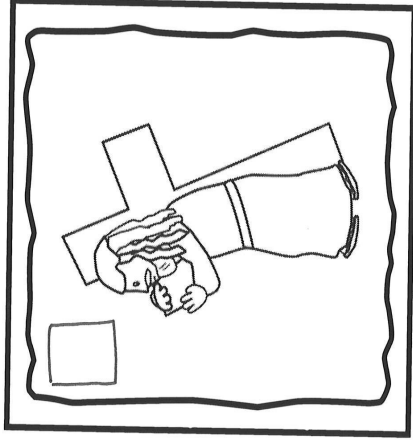
The Easter of the Bible
