¹³Someone in the crowd spoke to Jesus. "Teacher," he said, "tell my brother to divide the family property with me." ¹⁴Jesus replied, "Friend, who made me a judge or umpire between you?"

¹⁵Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against wanting to have more and more things. Life is not made up of how much a person has."

¹⁶Then Jesus told them a story. He said, "A certain rich man's land produced a very large crop. ¹⁷He thought to himself, 'What should I do? I don't have any place to store my crops.' ¹⁸Then he said, 'This is what I'll do. I will tear down my barns and build bigger ones. I will store my extra grain in them. ¹⁹I'll say to myself, 'You have plenty of grain stored away for many years. Take life easy. Eat, drink and have a good time.' "

And don't worry about your body and what you will wear. ²³There is more to life than eating. There are more important things for the body than clothes. ²⁴Think about the ravens. Store up riches in heaven that will never be used up. There, no thief can come near it. There, no moth can destroy it. ³⁴Your heart will be where your riches are."
